- ~ Respect the authority of the Golf Shop staff and take my complaints to the GM and/or Board of Directors if needed.
- ~ Uphold the tradition of the Club regarding my behavior both on and off the course as I represent the Club in our community.
- ~ Strive to **be an example of the rule rather than the exception to it.**
- ~ Play at or faster than the posted course pace of play (4 hours and 20 minutes). If the group behind me is faster, I will allow them to play through as soon as possible.
- ~ Repair all my divots and ball marks as well as an additional ball mark per green to maintain our excellent playing conditions.
- ~ Make every effort to keep my cart on the cart paths provided around all tees and greens. If I have a disability which prohibits me from doing so, I will display a blue flag on my cart.
- ~ Music is becoming more and more common on the golf course and the BCC is a fan. Please ensure that you and those riding with you are the only ones listening to your music.
- ~ Educate my guests as to the expectation of etiquette at the BCC.
